

### **Out of Bounds**

\*Flags, stakes, tree lines and tall grass provide visual aids for the painted OB lines. **Painted OB lines are** the official demarcation lines for out-of-bounds. The line is **OB**.

- 1. Tall grass and lake OB\*
- 2. Tall grass right & flags left OB\*
- 3. Asphalt right and beyond, flags left, tall grass, and mulch OB\*
- 4. Asphalt left and beyond and flags right OB\*
- 5. Asphalt right and beyond and over fence left OB\*
- 6. Asphalt right and beyond, tall grass and flags left OB\*
- 7. Tall grass left OB\*
- 8. Tall grass left and over right fence OB\*
- 9. Concrete, black top, tall grass and over fence OB\*
- 10. Asphalt right and beyond, tall grass left OB; Mando left of tree from blue tee. If mando is missed, go to drop zone (red tee) with one throw penalty. \*
- 11. Asphalt right and beyond, creek left OB. 2 meter lateral relief from barbed wire no closer to hole.
- 12. Tall grass left, basin flat, asphalt right and beyond OB\*
- 13. Tall grass left and flags right OB\*
- 14. Flags right and tree line left, asphalt and beyond OB\*
- 15. Metal stakes right and outside tree line left OB. If first throw goes OB, go to drop zone (red tee) with one throw penalty. All subsequent throws play normal OB rules. \*
- 16. Road left OB
- 17. Tall grass surrounding pond and pond OB.\*
- 18. Inside green house, roof of pump house, and over fences OB. Tall grass surrounding pond and pond OB. If first throw to purple basket goes OB, go to drop zone with one throw penalty. All subsequent throws play normal OB rules. \*

### **Etiquette and Courtesy**


Disc golf is a game that expects high standards of etiquette and courtesy. Among the basic considerations of etiquette are such things as concern for spectators and other players and respect for plant life on the course. Players should not throw until they are certain that the thrown disc will not distract another player or potentially injure anyone present. Players should watch the other members of their group throw in order to aid in locating errant throws and to ensure compliance with the rules.


### Out-of-Bounds (OB)


A disc that is considered out-of-bounds results in a one-throw penalty. The player may elect to play the next shot from a lie that is up to one meter away from and perpendicular to the point where the disc last crossed into out-of-bounds or the previous lie.

### Mandatories (mando)

A disc that has missed the mandatory results in a one-throw penalty and the next throw shall be made from the "Drop Zone" (DZ).












Tall Grass/ Tree Line OB









An area on the course, as designated by the course designer or tournament director, from which play is considered out-of-bounds.


The player must play the next shot from a "Drop Zone".









from the "Drop Zone".
